Summary of major changes for FY22

- For FY2022, the direct program costs included travel costs that are incremental to the Trawl Rationalization Program. Specifically, the travel costs for FY2022 were \$2,319.99. These costs are attributable to the IFQ sector (\$1,646.65), C/P sector (\$336.67), and the MS sector (\$336.67).
- Catch Monitor program under PSMFC: costs for the Catch Monitor program had an approximately 20% increase from 2021 to 2022 (\$253,182 to \$317,992 respectively). This increase was related to staffing changes within the Catch Monitor program.

- Implementation of Council actions, including development of use cases, and development, testing, and deployment of database modifications (IFQ, MS).
- Responding to data requests and providing information for development and analysis of several actions, including:
 - o Gear switching (IFQ)
 - o Whiting allocation utilization action (MS, C/P)
- Development of online permit applications for first receiver site licenses (IFQ).
- Development and implementation of Quota Share Owner Survey (IFQ).



Major New or Ad-Hoc Tasks for FY22 - Economics and Social Science Research Branch

- Support development of analyses related to the whiting utilization action (MS, C/P).
- Publication of Quota Share Owner Survey tech memo (IFQ)
- Quota share ownership analysis in support of sablefish gear switching action



Major New or Ad-Hoc Tasks for FY22 - Office of Law Enforcement

- Participate in designing programming updates for the online IFQ system (IFQ).
- Evaluate related enforcement implications in regards to new actions. (IFQ, C/P, MS).
