### Council Tasks

- 1. Adopt final preferred stock definition for all priority species
- 2. Review and adopt revisions to the FMP
- 3. Consider and give guidance on integrating proposed stock definition process into COP 9



### Scope of Action

- Managed groundfish stocks need to be defined
- 14 species considered
  - Black, canary, copper, quillback, & squarespot, vermilion & vermilion/sunset rockfishes
  - Dover, petrale, & rex soles
  - Lingcod, Pacific spiny dogfish, sablefish, & shortspine thornyhead



### Important Aspects of Action

- Definition delineates the stock boundaries
- Single OFL/ABC and harvest control rule for stock
- Status determined at same scale of definition
- Key aspects analyzed for identifying stock
  - Population structure
  - BSIA
  - Specifications/Management



### Analytical Findings by Species (§3.2.1 - §3.2.4)

### Single population, ACL, & status area:

Canary & squarespot rockfishes; Dover, petrale, & rex soles; & Pacific spiny dogfish, sablefish, & shortspine thornyhead

### Multiple populations, ACLs, & status areas:

Black, copper, quillback, vermilion & vermilion/sunset rockfishes and lingcod



### Range of Alternatives (§2)

No Action

Alternative (Alt) 1: Single stock – Pacific Coast

Alt. 2: 2 stocks – N & S of 40°10′ N. lat.

Alt. 2a: 2 stocks – N & S of 42° N. lat.

Alt.3: 3 stocks - WA, OR, and CA

Alt. 3a: 3 stocks -WA & OR, N of 34°27′ N. lat (NCA), &

S of 34°27′ N. lat (SCA)

Alt. 4: 4 stocks -WA, OR, NCA, and SCA



#### **Decision Points: March 2023**

- Preliminary preferred alternative (PPA) selected for 12 of the 14 priority species
- No PPA for vermilion and vermilion/sunset rockfishes
- Alternative 2a added to ROA for
  - Quillback rockfish
  - Vermilion & vermilion/sunset rockfishes
  - Not selected as PPA



### Preliminary Preferred Alternative (§2.1.2)

- Alt. 1 (§2.3): Canary & squarespot rockfishes; Dover, petrale, & rex soles; Pacific spiny dogfish, sablefish, & shortspine thornyhead (Pacific Coast stock)
- Alt. 2 (§2.4): Lingcod (N/S of 40°10' N. lat stocks)
- Alt. 2a (§2.4): Copper rockfish (N & S of 42° N. lat stocks)
- Alt. 3 (§2.5): Black & quillback rockfishes (WA, OR, & CA stocks)



### Quillback Rockfish: Alternative 2a (§3.3.6)

- Stock N of 42° N. lat. and a Stock S of 42° N. lat.
- Assessments of different categories [WA (Cat. 3) and OR (Cat. 2)] would be combined
- Uncertainty on whether status can/should be determined for the N of 42° N. lat
- May require Council to consider discretionary sharing agreement between WA and OR



## Quillback Rockfish: Alt. 2a/3 (PPA) Comparison

- Alts. 2a & 3 are finer scale than coastwide neither are contrary to BSIA
- Alt. 3 (PPA) eliminates Alt. 2a uncertainty on whether overfished status can/should be determined from the WA & OR (N of 42° N. lat.) stock
- Alt. 3 would not require discretionary sharing agreements between states



### Vermilion & Vermilion/Sunset Rf (§3.3.8)

- No PPA selected
- Considered under all Alts.
- Population structure is at a finer scale than coastwide
- Assessed in 4 areas:
  - WA & OR (vermilion rockfish only)
  - NCA & SCA (vermilion/sunset rockfishes)

### Vermilion and Vermilion/Sunset Rockfishes: Comparison

- Alt 1 does not reflect BSIA
- Alt. 2 would likely require new assessments
- Alt 3a may require Council to consider discretionary sharing agreement between WA and OR
- Alts 3 & 4:
  - Reflects assessment areas and BSIA
  - Would not require discretionary allocation/sharing agreements between states




### Stock Definition Process (§4)

- Two processes for Council consideration




#### COP 9 Timeline: Current






#### **Process Timeline 1**






#### **Process Timeline 2**
