



#### Search and Rescue

Coastal & Inland West Coast Region



In 2023, the USCG in the coastal and inland waters off California, Oregon and Washington conducted:

- **3,321** search and rescue (SAR) cases
- Saved over 800 lives, assisted 4,500
- Over \$170 million in property saved or assisted

Specific to commercial fisheries, the USCG responded to:

- **258** SAR cases
- Saved **17** lives





## F/V Ethel May

Persons in the Water February 2023



- In February, the USCG received a relayed 911 call and EPRIB simultaneously from a fishing vessel in distress in vicinity of Willapa Bay, WA.
- Vessel was struck by waves, and only 02 of 03 persons on board were able to enter the inflatable liferaft.
- Over 1,000 track miles searched and included air, surface, shoreside and local law enforcement support.





# F/V JUDY Aground

September 2023



- 51' steel tuna troller reported to the USCG that they ran aground in Yaquina Bay, OR.
- Operator admitted to have fallen asleep.
- Members of USCG Station Yaquina Bay responded shoreside & assessed for medical concerns.






## F/V Evening

*Overdue*October 2023



- USCG Station Grays Harbor received a report of an overdue fishing vessel out of Westport, WA.
- Air and surface search assets launched from 3 different USCG Districts.
- 01 survivor found by Good Samaritans on a Canadian-based fishing vessel.






## Commercial Fishing Vessel Safety

Violation Data & Lives Lost



#### In 2023:

- 22% of commercial fishing vessels boarded had safety violations.
- 5% of those violations involved Especially Hazardous Conditions resulting in termination of voyage.

• 24/7 Whale Watch – dedicated personnel to take reports and make notifications.

#### Ways to Report:

- Via VHF channels 5a and 14



## **Fast Response Cutters**

2024 Initiatives - Coming Soon to D13



- 2 new Fast Response Cutters will be homeported in Astoria, OR.
- Multiple-mission platform with increased capability and sea-keeping for offshore search and rescue and law enforcement.
- USCGC DAVID DURAN commissioning June of 2024.
- USCGC FLORENCE FINCH commissioning October of 2024.
