The Coastal Pelagic Species Advisory Subpanel (CPSAS) supports the process moving forward to realize efficiencies in the Council's Operating Procedures. We believe that reducing CPSAS in-person participation to two meetings can allow for effective participation by the subpanel (A.1). In some cases, it may be necessary to extend meetings a day to provide sufficient time to complete the agenda.
