## CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE REPORT ON INTERNATIONAL HIGHLY MIGRATORY SPECIES (HMS) MANAGEMENT

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) reviewed the proposed range of options provided in the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) supplemental report (<u>Agenda Item J.2.a</u> <u>REVISED 2 Supplemental NMFS Report 2</u>). This report provides recommendations for potential Pacific bluefin tuna 2025-2026 trip limits, in order to provide a broad range of options for Pacific Fishery Management Council consideration at the November Council meeting. CDFW is providing proposed edits to the NMFS options to achieve the following:

- 1) Ensure the range is broad enough to encompass potential options for consideration
- 2) Ensure that the high-end option is more likely to achieve full use of the two-year quota
- 3) Correct the maximum allowed take in the second year, which cannot exceed 1285 mt regardless of total catch in the first year (per <u>Agenda Item J.2 Attachment 2</u>)

The following table (Table 1) describes the options, highlighting places where we recommend changes from the NMFS options, and adding an option between "Running Start" and "Pedal to the Floor," which we have named "Run Down the Middle."
