## NATIONAL MARINE FISHERIES SERVICE REPORT

The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) West Coast Region is expected to briefly update the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) regarding recent regulatory developments relevant to groundfish fisheries and issues of interest to the Council including its current workload and rulemaking plans for 2024 and early 2025.

The NMFS Northwest Fisheries Science Center (NWFSC) is expected to discuss current groundfish-related science and research activities with the Council. The NWFSC has provided two reports for Council discussion. The first report is Pacific halibut bycatch in groundfish fisheries (Agenda Item E.1.b, NWFSC Report 1) and the report's data in MS Excel format (Agenda Item E.1.b, NWFSC Report 2). The second report relates to salmon bycatch in groundfish fisheries (Agenda Item E.1.b, NWFSC Report 3) which is accompanied by the report's data in MS Excel format (Agenda Item E.1.b, NWFSC Report 4).
