

SALMON TECHNICAL TEAM REPORT ON
THE PROPOSED APRIL 2025 MEETING SCHEDULE

The Salmon Technical Team (STT) discussed the proposed Pacific Fishery Management Council agenda for April 2025, which is currently proposed to be four days long. In the past, the April meeting has been five and a half days long.

The STT would be able to evaluate potential management measures within the proposed four days but looks to the states and tribes to weigh in on whether the compressed schedule might affect their ability to develop management measures that meet the relevant criteria in time to provide the STT with the necessary model inputs.
