

I.6 Inseason Adjustments and Technical Corrections for 2025-2026

Council Action:

Adopt Final Inseason Adjustments for 2024 and 2025, including Pacific Whiting Off the Top Bycatch Deductions; Technical Corrections to the 2025-2026 Harvest Specifications and Management Measures, as Appropriate:

1. Adopt final inseason adjustments for 2024 and 2025 as necessary, to achieve, but not exceed, annual catch limits and other management objectives, as appropriate.
2. Adopt Pacific whiting yield set-asides for 2025.
3. Consider any technical corrections to the 2025-2026 harvest specifications, as appropriate.

I move the Council adopt the following inseason adjustments, as recommended by the GAP (Agenda Item I.6.a Supplemental GAP Report 1) and GMT (Agenda Item I.6.a Supplemental GMT Report 1):

1. Set the 2025 Pacific whiting set-aside for research and the pink shrimp fishery at 750 mt.
2. Increase the Open Access trip limit for shelf rockfish in the area between 40° 10' N. lat. and 42° N to 1600 lbs/2months as shown in Option 1, Table 4 of Agenda Item I.6.a Supplemental GMT Report 1.
