2025 West Coast Groundfish Bottom Trawl Survey

Pass 1

- Mobilization (Newport, OR): May 12 17
- Survey (US CAN to US Mex): May 18 Jul. 15
- Demobilization (Newport, OR): Jul. 22 23
- Two contracted fishing vessels: F/V Last Straw and F/V Excalibur

Pass 2

- Mobilization (Newport, OR): Aug. 18 23
- Survey (US CAN to US Mex): Aug. 24 Oct. 21
- Demobilization (Newport, OR): Oct. 27 28

 Two contracted fishing vessels: F/V Ms. Julie and F/V Noah's Ark

2025 So. CA Shelf Rockfish Hook & Line Survey

- Partnership among PSMFC, NWFSC, and Industry
- •Annually since 2003 (pilot study), **20**-year time series:
 - 2004 2019; 2021 2024
- •Underway Sep 24 through Oct 9, 2025
 - Leg 1 Sep 24 30
 - Port Call Oct 1 2, Long Beach CA
 - Leg 2 Oct 3 9
 - Demobilization Oct 10, Long Beach CA
- •Conducted with three vessels from the local sportfishing

industry (Mirage, Aggressor, Toronado)





2025 Integrated West Coast Pelagics Survey (NWC, SWC, DFO)

A robust fisheries-independent integrated survey that supports sustainable fisheries for Pacific hake and coastal pelagics, increases ecosystem data collection, and maintains the survey schedule.

- NOAA ship Shimada and Canadian ship Franklin
- Franklin gear trials on Strait of Georgia Survey Feb 18 -March 2 and Shimada gear trials March 4 - 7
- Survey will be conducted June 11 Sept 14
 - U.S.-Mexico to Dixon Entrance, AK
- Acoustics (5 freq), 24-hr trawling (midwater & surface) and environmental sampling/eDNA
- Will use new Multifunction Trawl System (MFT)
