

F.1 Incidental Catch Limits for 2025 Salmon Troll Fishery - Final Action

Council Tasks:

Adopt final landing restrictions for Pacific halibut caught incidentally in the non-tribal salmon troll fishery May 16, 2025, through the end of the 2025 salmon troll season, and prior to the effective date of 2026 management measures unless modified through inseason action.

Council Action:

Adopt Final Incidental Pacific Halibut Catch Recommendations for 2025 and Early 2026 Non-Indian Salmon Troll Fisheries

F.1 WDFW Motion – Incidental Catch Limits for Salmon Troll Fishery:

I move the Council adopt the Option 1 (status quo) catch limit for the 2025 salmon fishery as described in

Supplemental Salmon Advisory Subpanel Report 1 under
Agenda Item F.1.a, April 2025.

Option 1 (status quo) Open May 16, 2025, through the end of the 2025 salmon troll fishery, and beginning April 1, 2026, until modified through inseason action or superseded by the 2026 management measures. License holders may land no more than one Pacific halibut per two Chinook, except one Pacific halibut may be landed without meeting the ratio requirement, and no more than 35 halibut landed per trip.
