INSEASON MANAGEMENT - FINAL ACTION

Under this agenda item, the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) will be informed by the Groundfish Management Team (GMT) regarding the status of the groundfish fishery relative to harvest goals and objectives. The Council will consider, as appropriate, inseason adjustments to routine groundfish management measures to attain, but not exceed, the annual catch limits. Inseason adjustments are, in part, based on recent landings data and the latest information from the West Coast Groundfish Observer Program. The most recent groundfish landings data are available on PacFIN's <u>APEX website</u> in report GMT007. The GMT and the Groundfish Advisory Subpanel (GAP) are expected to provide the Council with reports on inseason adjustments requests by stakeholders, as applicable.

Council Tasks:

- 1. Consider groundfish catch and projections, as appropriate.
- 2. Adopt 2025 inseason adjustments, as necessary.
