# Pacific Fishery Management Council to Hold a Meeting June 11-16, 2025 to Adopt Management Measures for Ocean Fisheries

The Pacific Fishery Management Council (PFMC or Council) and its advisory bodies will meet June 11-16, 2025 in Rohnert Park, California and via webinar. The Council meeting will be live streamed with the opportunity to provide public comment in person and remotely starting Friday, June 13, at 9 a.m., and reconvening at 8 a.m. on Saturday, June 14, through Monday, June 16, 2025. All meetings are open to the public, except for a Closed Session held from 8 a.m. to 9 a.m., Friday, June 13, to address litigation and personnel matters. Advisory body meetings will be conducted via a combination of online and in-person formats as described on the last pages of the attached proposed meeting agenda. Instructions for joining online meetings will be posted to the June 2025 Meeting webpage. Briefing materials will be available on the June 2025 Meeting webpage no later than Friday, May 23, 2025 by the end of the day.

The Council is scheduled to address issues related to groundfish, highly migratory species (HMS), and administrative matters. Several agenda items have impacts that span multiple fishery management plans (FMPs) and are labeled "Cross FMP." Key actions for consideration at the meeting include:

Groundfish

- Final action for the limited entry fixed gear follow-on actions including gear endorsements, cost recovery, and other administrative changes
- Inseason management
- Adopt update stock assessments for yelloweye and widow rockfishes
- Adopt the final intersector allocation review
- Identify species in need of conservation and management including establishing their stock definitions, consideration to remove selected species from the FMP or designate them as ecosystem components
- Initial scoping for harvest specifications and management measures for 2027-28 including adopting a process and schedule

HMS

- Provide recommendations on U.S. positions at upcoming meetings and other forums, as appropriate
- Preliminary review of exempted fishing permit applications
- Adopt the roadmap and provide guidance on priorities and next steps for HMS fisheries

# Cross FMP

- Receive a briefing on recent Presidential Executive Orders and generate a response for public review
- Adopt the final research and data needs for Council managed fisheries

The declared COVID health emergency is over; however, the Council recommends that participants follow the guidelines provided by health authorities. Council participants are encouraged to bring masks and tests to the meeting in the event they are needed. A limited supply of tests and masks will be available in the Council Ballroom.

All meetings are open to the public and there will be an opportunity to participate and provide oral testimony in person and remotely for the Council session. For more information on the meetings, refer to the attached proposed detailed agenda. The meeting of the Council will be live streamed on the internet. The broadcast will begin at 9 a.m. on Friday, June 13, 2025. The meeting will continue daily at 8 a.m. through Monday, June 16. Broadcasts end daily at 5 p.m. or when business for the day is complete. Only the audio portion and presentations displayed on the screen will be broadcast. The audio portion for the public is listen-only except that an opportunity for oral public comment will be provided prior to Council Action on each agenda item. To access the meeting online, please visit the June 2025 Meeting webpage. It is recommended that you use a computer headset to listen to the meeting, but you may use your telephone for the audio-only portion of the meeting.

Advisory body meetings will be conducted in person and online according to the schedules in the attached proposed agenda. There will be an opportunity for public comment daily in each of the meetings. Instructions for how to connect to meetings being held via webinar will be posted on the Council's June 2025 Meeting webpage prior to the first day of the meeting.

# **Public Comment Guidelines**

Additionally, there will be an opportunity for oral public comment in person and remotely prior to Council Action on each agenda item. Written comments after the Council meeting starts will only be accepted if they are in support of oral public comment and are submitted via the <u>E-Portal</u> prior to Council Action on the agenda item.
