## **ODFW Guidance**

Request the GMT, Council, and NMFS staff:

- begin to examine canary rockfish allocations, building off the work conducted for the 2025-2026 biennial harvest specifications ([Agenda Item F.7.a, Supplemental GMT Report 2, March 2024](#)) in preparation for the upcoming 2027-2028 biennial process. Using historical sector-specific sharing and mortality below as starting place :
  - 2015-2016 specifications sharing, last sharing before 2015 assessment
  - 2016 mortality by sector, last year before higher ACLs resulting from the 2015 assessment
  - 2017-2018 specifications sharing, first sharing with higher ACLs resulting from the 2015 assessment
  - 2024 mortality by sector, most recent year's mortality

- o 2025-2026 specifications sharing, which is the most recent specifications sharing
- Explore sub-trip limits for the shelf rockfish complex north of 40° 10' N. lat.
- Explore changes to California recreational fishery to remove recreational Rockfish Conservation Areas in favor of management via sub-bag limits only
