

SALMON ADVISORY SUBPLANEL REPORT ON
COUNCIL RESPONSE TO EXECUTIVE ORDERS AND ADMINISTRATION UPDATES

The Salmon Advisory Subpanel (SAS) discussed the attachments included under Agenda Item H.2, Council Response to Executive Orders and Administration Updates. The SAS supports sending Council Member Report 1 to Secretary Lutnick, explicitly the bullets on domestic infrastructure and West Coast salmon recovery, including their sub-bullets, as copied below:

- Support domestic infrastructure
 - Expand and update port infrastructure (e.g., ice houses, funding for port/harbor dredging)
 - Seafood processing infrastructure
 - Evaluate the impacts of the Jones Act on fishing fleet modernization
 - Create programs (education, loans) to bring young fishermen to fishing industry
 - Design coastal and marine spatial planning that supports U.S. fishermen

- Support West Coast salmon recovery
 - Address water quality and quantity, pinniped, avian and invasive aquatic species predation
 - Increase hatchery production to provide more opportunity and access to socially, and culturally important fish
