I move the Council adopt inseason action to:

- increase the commercial non-trawl canary rockfish trip limits north and south of 40°10' N. latitude to 4,000 lbs. per two months for limited entry fixed gear (LEFG), and 2,000 lbs. per two months for open access (OA)
- increase the canary rockfish sub-bag limit from 1-fish to 2-fish for the Oregon recreational long-leader fishery and reduce the long-leader fishery bag limit from 12-fish to 10-fish

as recommended by the GAP ([Agenda Item D.5.a, Supplemental GAP Report 1, March 2026](#)) and GMT Option 2 in Table 1 ([Agenda Item D.5.a, Supplemental GMT Report 1, March 2026](#))
