

SACRAMENTO RIVER FALL CHINOOK WORKGROUP REPORT ON
MEMBERSHIP APPOINTMENTS AND COUNCIL OPERATING PROCEDURES

The Sacramento River fall Chinook Workgroup (SRWG) staffing issues noted in November 2025 ([Agenda Item G.4.a, SRWG Report 1, page 19](#)) have only become more acute. The Northwest Fisheries Science Center seat remains vacant and Dr. Correigh Greene is no longer assisting in a voluntary capacity, meaning the SRWG has lost its member with the most expertise in habitat conditions. The United States Fish and Wildlife seat also remains vacant, and one California Department of Fish and Wildlife seat is now vacant as well.
