

INSEASON MANAGEMENT – FINAL ACTION

Under this agenda item, the Pacific Fishery Management Council (Council) will be informed by the Groundfish Management Team (GMT) regarding the status of the groundfish fishery relative to harvest goals and objectives. The GMT and the Groundfish Advisory Subpanel (GAP) may recommend inseason adjustments to the Council under this agenda item. The GMT will evaluate the requests to ensure harvest objectives are met and present the results of their analysis to the Council.

The Council will consider, as appropriate, inseason adjustments to routine groundfish management measures, e.g., trip limits, to achieve harvest goals and objectives. The GMT is also expected to report attainment levels of groundfish stocks to date and any retrospective information pertinent to fishery performance for Council consideration. The most recent groundfish landings data are available on PacFIN's [APEX website](#) in report GMT007.

Council Tasks:

- 1. Consider groundfish catch and projections, as appropriate.**
- 2. Adopt 2026 inseason adjustments, as necessary.**
