F/V Aleutian Storm *Aground* February 2024

- In February 2024, the 50' steel hulled F/V Aleutian Storm ran aground south of Bodega Bay with 4 POB, who were rescued.
- The vessel broke apart in the surf and was a total loss.





F/V Westerly *Aground* March 2024

- In March 2024, the F/V Westerly, a troller, ran aground on the rocks near Pt Reyes with 1 POB, deceased.
- The Vessel broke apart in the surf and was a total loss.

F/V Miss Jessie *Aground* July 2025

- In July 2025, the 50' steel hulled F/V Miss Jessie ran aground south of Humboldt Bay due to a loss of steering.
- The 5 POB, who were hoisted to safety.
- The vessel was salvaged.



F/V Karolee

Fall Overboard

August 2025

- In August 2025, the F/V Karolee, a wooden salmon troller, was reported overdue by family members.
- The owner normally fished off La Push, WA but was located 80 NM SW of Coos Bay, OR.
- A C-27 located the vessel and CGC SEA LION intercepted and boarded with no one onboard. The vessel was towed to Eureka.
- An extensive search was conducted without located the owner. Two weeks after finding the vessel, the owner's body washed ashore near La Push, WA. He was presumed to have fallen overboard while fishing.
