The Highly Migratory Species Advisory Subpanel (HMSAS) recommends that the Council place on its agenda, at least by the April 2011 meeting, the subject of the California Ocean Protection Council and the Governor's Agreement between the governors of the states of California, Oregon, and Washington and how activities interface with those of the Council in areas of fisheries management. In addition, the HMSAS requests that it receive a briefing from NOAA-Fisheries on Ocean Spatial Planning at its next HMSAS meeting.
